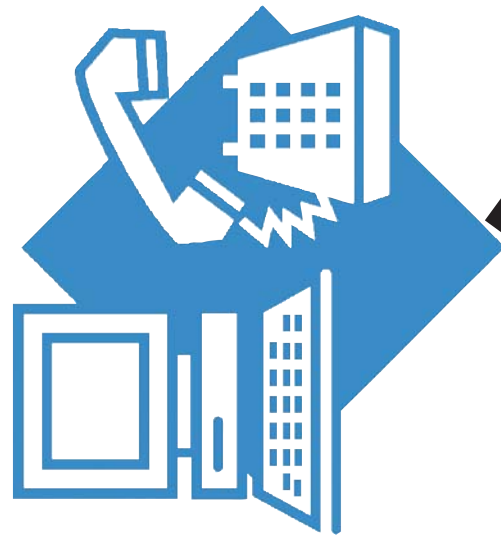

The service is not intended to replace person-to-person contact, but rather to offer you the convenience of information 24-hours a day, 7 days a week. Info Connection is also available online at www.ci.norwalk.ca.us

If you have a life-threatening emergency, please call 911 directly for immediate person-to-person assistance.

How to use Info Connection:

Have paper and pen or pencil handy to take notes. Using a touchtone phone, simply dial (562)484-9660 then enter the 4-digit code for any of the more than 200 messages listed in this brochure. You may enter a code at any time. To hear a new message just enter the next desired code. You can access up to 4 messages and fax documents per call. To exit simply hang up.




